

RULES & CONDITIONS

- 1. The show is run in accordance with the byelaws of the Dartmoor Pony Society, as amended/updated by Council.
- 2. All ponies must be registered in the main body of the Dartmoor Pony Society Stud Book, SR1 or SR2 registers. Registration numbers must be quoted on the entry form.
- 3. Only ponies owned by a Dartmoor Pony Society Member will be eligible to receive any DPS Rosettes. Membership Card must be produced in the ring at the time of presentation.
- 4. Stallions or Colts aged **THREE YEARS OLD OR OVER** may not be shown unless in possession of a Dartmoor Pony Society Stallion Licence.
- 5. Handlers of Stallions and Colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of Stallions must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 6. It is MANDATORY that all Ridden Stallions wear a Stallion Bridle Disk and ADVIOSRY for In Hand Stallion and Colts.
- 7. All classes affiliated to the National Pony Society will be run under their rules.
- 8. The Judges decision will be final.
- 9. Midlands DPS or any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be held responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from/to any animal, property or vehicle brought onto the showground, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the Show or to the conditions or rules prescribed by the Committee thereto.
- 10. No Animals may be corralled anywhere on the showground.
- 11. It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that horses/ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers/lorries.
- 12. In the interest of safety, please obey the instructions of the Show Committee or any other Official of the Show at all times.
- 13. Lunging is permitted in allocated areas only.
- 14. Objections to entries or awards must be made in writing to the Secretary, on the Show Day accompanied by a deposit of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained. All objections shall be delivered to the Secretariat within an hour of the occurrence/incident otherwise they will not be considered.
- 15. Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal, including the spread of infection or contagious disease or article exhibited or introduced to the showground by him or her and shall indemnify the Show and its officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the Show.
- 16. No Member/Competitor/Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony in a class where the Judge has owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced that pony or where the pony has been owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced by the Judge's immediate family (husband, wife, parents, children, brother or sister) partner, employer or employee. An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced, broken or trained an equine since 1st October in the previous year.
- 17. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn at all times when mounted and also by competitors in Young Handler classes: PAS 015 2011; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2023; ASTM F1163 2015 & 2023 onwards; SNELL E2016 onwards; AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags)
- 18. No spurs to be worn at any time.
- 19. Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory minimum requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old. This Rule may be subject to change following guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the NPS website.
- 20. Rules of the Dartmoor Pony Society must be adhered to by all competitors. Rules are on the Dartmoor Pony Society website (http://www.dartmoorponysociety.com/shows).

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following: Won an open affiliated WHP class, Qualified for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Open WHP classes, Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year). If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Novice WHP Final.

Class 36 Junior Working Hunter Pony *Open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings, four years old or over registered in the main body of the Dartmoor Pony Society Stud Book. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, LIHS or RIHS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. **Kindly Sponsored by Milator Stud**

NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th-8th August, 2024. The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships, Breed Show Rules:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. At breed shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of the qualified pony must become an Adult Qualifying or Life member to enter the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

MIDLANDS DARTMOOR RESIDING CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship is open to pure bred ponies that are bred/exhibited/owned by a DPS Member who resides in the Midlands. Exhibits eligible to compete for this championship must wear a **Black** armband in their classes, and also in the championship. The highest place exhibit in each class, will receive a card and will be entitled to go forward to the Midlands Dartmoor Residing Championship. For this show, the definition of 'Midlands' is as follows: Staffordshire, Warwickshire, Shropshire, Herefordshire, Worcestershire, Lincolnshire, Northamptonshire, Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire, Leicestershire and Rutland.

MIDLANDS DARTMOOR PONY SHOW RESTRICTED CLASSES

Open to Pure Bred Dartmoor Ponies who have not won a 1st prize at a Dartmoor Pony Society Star Show before 1st January in the current year. These Classes are not affiliated to any society but will still run under the rules of the DPS.

MIDLANDS DARTMOOR PONY SHOW HOME PRODUCED CLASSES - To be run under the rules of the National Pony Society

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor ponies that have been stabled at home (without any paid assistance) or kept at livery on a DIY basis or at stud, since 1st January in the current year. The pony is to be owned/kept, produced, ridden/handled by a person who does not receive remuneration in cash or kind from working with horses/ponies, or acts as a Brand Ambassador. This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets. (Stud Fees and associated costs are also excluded) No professional producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the horse/pony. Rider/handlers must not have shown any horse/pony produced by a Professional producer/trainer/groom at any show since 1st January in the current year. Ponies must not be shown by a rider/handler who has shown for a Professional producer/Trainer is - A person who keeps horses/ponies, including training, livery, schooling, rides or handles equines for the show ring for more than one exhibitor/owner paid or unpaid since 1st January of the preceding year.

NB: MIDLANDS DARTMOOR PONY SHOW EXPECTS COMPETITORS TO ACCEPT THE RULES OF HOME PRODUCED COMPETITIONS IN THE SPIRIT INTENDED.
